My Fellow Veteran,

As your former Commander of the Special Guerilla Units in Laos and today Honorary Chairman of the SGU Veterans and Families of USA, Inc. I am exploring all opportunities to enhance and assist with getting the Congress of the United States to provide appropriate benefits and services for our deserving SGU Veterans who fought so bravely for the United States during the Vietnam War.

In order to provide an effective recording system, the SGU Veterans & Families of USA, Inc. created a membership program which includes the registration of your military history and military data information. This will provide the United States Congress with information that you are an actual SGU Veteran who served during the Vietnam War, and are eligible to receive potential benefits in the future. This is the first time we have registered our SGU Veterans as veterans with the United States Government in Washington, D.C.

I believe it to be crucial that we ask the United States government to provide the SGU Veterans residing in the United States with burial benefits, hospital care, nursing home care and medical service. I believe an enactment of legislation should be presented to Congress of the United States for these long overdue benefits.

As your former Commander of the SGU Veterans, it is my responsibility to identify, verify and sign off on the military record of each of the SGU Veteran application. Colonel James W. Lair and I both established the Special Guerrilla Units for the United States in Laos during the Vietnam War, and now we are both again working together in registering the SGU Veterans for future benefits.

A United States Congressman from the State of California is preparing a House of Representatives Bill to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to inter in national cemeteries, individuals who supported the United States in South East Asia during the Vietnam War. For those individuals who the Secretary determines served in support of the Armed Forces (including support involving any covert action of the United States, as defined in section 503) of the National Security Act of 1947, in the Kingdom of Laos during the period beginning February 28, 1961 and ending on May 7, 1975, for the Department of Veterans Affairs to provide burial benefits in National Cemeteries.

I have appointed Paula Yang of Fresno, California to be the Project Coordinator Consultant for the SGU Veterans and Families of USA, Inc, for this registration program

Dr. Charles Waters of Fresno, California as the SGU Veterans legislative consultant who has the knowledge and experience in the legislative process of the United States Congress.

William E Dietzel, Chief Executive Officer, Consultant firm of Veterans Magazine, Inc, Fresno, California, Appointed as Director of Marketing for the National SGU Veterans and Families of U.S.A., Inc. Registration Program.

I am encouraging all SGU Veterans to cooperate by providing your military information as proof to the United States Congress that you are a SGU Veteran who fought for the United States during the Vietnam War
